



Conversion therapy (CT) is the practice of trying to change someone's sexual orientation, gender identity, or gender expression. It means trying to turn a gay or bisexual person straight, or trying to force a person to identify with the gender they were assigned at birth.

CONVERSION THERAPY IS ILLEGAL IN CANADA



People who have been exposed to CT are more likely to feel isolated, abuse substances, and seek mental health supports.



It is illegal to provide, promote, advertise, or profit from conversion therapy. Sentences can be as high as 5 years in prison.
